General Care and Maintenance for Delicate Non-Vinyl

General Cleaning/Maintenance

General maintenance can be achieved with periodic dusting and/or vacuuming of materials. We recommend when vacuuming that you only use a soft bristle attachment to avoid damaging materials. We recommend you avoid using dusting sprays such as Pledge, as these chemicals may alter the coloration of goods.

Marks and Stains

Due to the nature of these products, we do not recommend attempting to clean with conventional means, such as with soap and water. The textures and contents are very natural, and may flake and come apart when cleaned. It is recommended you hold additional yardage and piece in additional material when needed.

However, if cleaning is required, we recommend extra care. Please note that Innovations is not responsible to damage of these goods during the cleaning process, as we advise against it. We recommend you clean a sample or inconspicuous piece of your material to ensure no adverse effects occur to the coloration or gloss of your product. We recommend you follow the bullet points listed below for removal of marks and stains.

- Use mild soap and warm water as your cleaning solution. Avoid all solvent based cleaners.
- Only use soft or natural sponges, an abrasive sponge can ruin wallcovering.
- Use a very conservative application, as over soaking materials may damage them. It is recommended you ring out your sponge prior to cleaning.
- Use a blotting action, rather than scrubbing materials. Scrubbing may result in abrasion of your materials.
- Very lightly rinse material with clean water after cleaning.
- Dry immediately with a soft, lint-free cloth or towel.

For Flocked Patterns

We recommend using a fabric brush when smoothing flock.
