

General Care and Maintenance for Faux Leather

General Cleaning/Maintenance

General maintenance can be achieved with periodic dusting and/or vacuuming of materials. We recommend when vacuuming that you only use a soft bristle attachment to avoid damaging materials.

Marks and Stains

When cleaning marks and stains, we recommend you clean a sample or inconspicuous piece of your material to ensure no adverse effects occur to the coloration or gloss of your product. We recommend you follow the bullet points listed below for removal of marks and stains.

- Use mild soap and warm water as your cleaning solution. Avoid all solvent based cleaners unless necessary (please see below).
- Rinse material with clean water after cleaning.
- Material should air dry.

Stubborn Marks and Stains (ink, tar, gum, blood, crayon, glue, etc.)

If the cleaning methods above do not suffice, stubborn stains can be approached with more powerful cleaning solutions. We recommend you spray an alcohol based solution such as Fantastik or Formula 409, or even a solution of isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) on the stain. This helps set the stain, which then may be wiped away using soap and water with a sponge.

For very stubborn stains, a 10:1 water to bleach solution can be used. We do advise against this and recommend only as a last resort, as this can affect color fastness during the longevity of your product.

After marks and stains have been removed, wipe away solutions with clean water and air dry.
